

Kindergarten Supply List 2018-2019

Personal Supplies: (Please label these items with your child's name)

*Backpack (large enough to put a folder in without bending it, small enough that your child can carry it comfortably, no wheels please)

- 2 two-pocket folders (please be sure pockets are on the bottom rather than the sides, designs or colors of your choice)
- Change of clothes packed in ziploc bag to be stored in your child's backpack (socks, underwear, shirt and pants.)

Shared Supplies: (Please DO NOT label these with your child's name.)

- 2 packages of Ticonderoga #2 pencils (sharpened if possible)
- 12 Elmer's glue sticks
- 2 large pink erasers
- 1 pair of small scissors (Fiskars blunt-tip scissors are recommended, not pointy tip scissors)
- 1 - 1" white presentation binder, with clear front pocket (Hagen/Smith only)
- 1 box of 24 Crayola Crayons
- 1 pack of Crayola Twistable crayons (**basic 8 color pack only please**) *See picture. If you cannot find these at the store, they are available on Amazon.com or other online sites. Please contact your teacher if you need help finding this item.
- 1 box of Kleenex/Tissue
- 1 package of baby wipes (unscented)
- 1 pair of inexpensive kid's headphones (to use with iPads, no earbuds please)
- 1 box of pre-packaged snacks: Examples: fruit snacks, granola bars, goldfish packets (Your child will be asked to send a pre-packaged snack each month)



Optional Items: Please choose at least 1 (or more ☺) of the following items

- Play-Doh (4 pack)
- Elmer's Extreme large glue sticks
- Large variety pack of plastic silverware (forks, spoons, & knives)
- 1 roll of double-stick tape (Hagen/Smith only)
- 1 box of gallon sized Ziploc bags or sandwich size Ziploc bags (Hagen/Smith only)

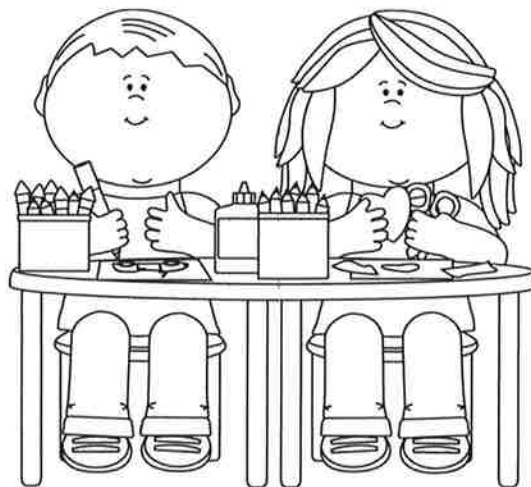
- One box of 24 crayons

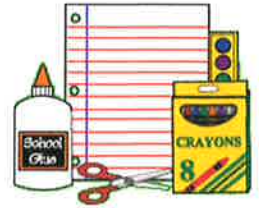
